MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC WORKSHOP TO SOLICIT COMMENTS  
PERTAINING TO TEMPORARY PROPOSED REGULATIONS  
Las Vegas, Nevada

The Public Workshop to Solicit Comments Pertaining to Temporary Proposed Regulations (Public Workshop) of the Board of Examiners for Social Workers (Board), LCB File Number T001-16, was called to order by C.J. Yao, Board member, at 1:00 p.m. The Public Workshop was conducted at Mojave Adult Clinic, 4000 East Charleston Blvd., Las Vegas, Nevada. The process to properly notice this Workshop was conducted in accordance with NRS 233B (State's Administrative Rule Making) and NRS 241 (State's Open Meeting Law). Both of the Public Workshop locations in Las Vegas and Reno had copies of the proposed regulation changes to NAC 641B, with these proposed changes highlighted in yellow. Ms. Yao noted that the purpose of this Public Workshop was to record public input by any interested individuals pertaining to this proposed regulation change. Ms. Yao noted that present during this workshop was a recorder who was assigned to record any public comment. Roll call was then conducted by Ms. Yao, with the following individuals present:

OPEN WORKSHOP

A summary of the proposed regulation changes in T001-16 are as follows (Agenda Item 2A):

Section 1 Provides clarification pertaining to an application for licensure or renewal being complete prior to being processed.

Section 2 Allows for the issue of a provisional, one-year license to an applicant for endorsement of a similar out-of-state license, contingent upon initial receipt of specified information and the provision of the remaining required information within the one-year period of provisional licensure.

Section 3 Pertains to fees the Board shall charge and collect for applicants via endorsement pursuant to NRS 641B.271 and NRS 641B.272.

Section 4 Establishes criteria under which a Clinical Social Worker, licensed by the Board, may engage in the certification and decertification process of individuals under an involuntary hold, under NRS 641B.160(2), Chapter 433A of NRS, pursuant to SB 7.

Section 5 Indicated that Sections 1 through 4 become effective upon filing with the Nevada Office of the Secretary of State.
