The Board has expanded the content areas that will count for ethics CEUs (Sec.23 – NAC 641B.187.1(A)(1) and NAC 641B.187.1(B)(1)).

Four hours must relate to ethics in the practice of social work, including, without limitation, at least one of the issues addressing -

- professional boundaries,
- confidentiality,
- dual relationships,
- documentation,
- billing,
- fraud,
- telehealth,
- supervision,
- social media,
- sexual harassment,
- exploitation of clients,
- managing job stress,
- social work laws and regulations,
- cultural competency and racial biases,
- risk management,
- mandated reporting,
- scope of practice,
- professional conduct,
- standards of care,
- impaired professionals; and/or
- certifications for an emergency admission, release from an emergency admission or involuntary court-ordered,
